### *\*DEFINITIONS & NOTES:*

**Anthropology** – Students may replace ANTH 101 with an upper level elective.

**Biology** – Placement depends on department exam results. Students must obtain a 6 or 7 HL score to be eligible to take the department exam.

**Chemistry** – Students are required to take the on-line chemistry placement survey during the month of June and to have a follow-up meeting with the department for placement during First Days. Students are encouraged to contact one of the CHEM 151/153/155 instructors with questions.

**Computer Science** – Students should consult with the department to confirm appropriate placement.

**Economics** – Students receiving a 6 or 7 HL score may place out of ECON 110 and 120.

**French** – Placement depends on department exam results.

**Physics** – Placement depends on HL score, department placement exam results and individual conferences.

**Spanish** – Placement depends on department exam results.

**Theatre** – Students should confer with the department chair about proper placement.
